PRAGUE MUNICIPAL BUDGET STRUCTURE OF REVENUES IN 2010 (IN MIL. EUR)





PRAGUE MUNICIPAL BUDGET STRUCTURE OF EXPENDITURES IN 2010 (IN MIL. EUR)


















